

Send This File

Instructions for Sending and Receiving large files via e-mail using "Send This File" service.

Signing up for free service:

Sign in to <http://www.sendthisfile.com> Click-on [Register Free Account] Ref. File.. STF_01.bmp
Type in your e-mail address and password. [Register]

Signing in to use the "Send This File" service:

Sign in to <https://www.sendthisfile.com/login.jsp> and enter your e-mail address and password. And click [Login] [Next]

The following window comes up. Ref. File.. STF_02.bmp

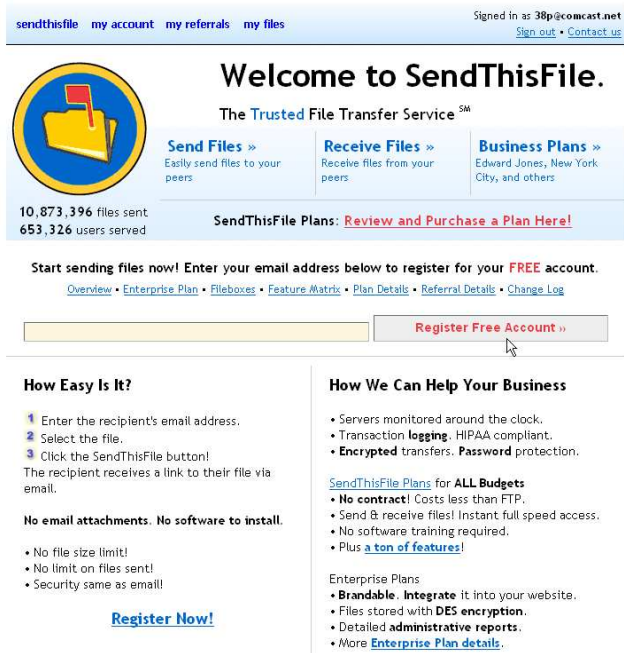
Fill in the "To" "Subject" "Message" and "File1" fields. Click [Send This File] when done.

Note: Use the [Browse] to find and select the file to be sent. **It's a good idea to identify yourself as sender in subject line.**

A confirmation window comes up when the file is sent.. Click [Next]

The screen goes back to the "Send This File" window. Ref. File.. STF_02.bmp

Send another file or close out if finished.

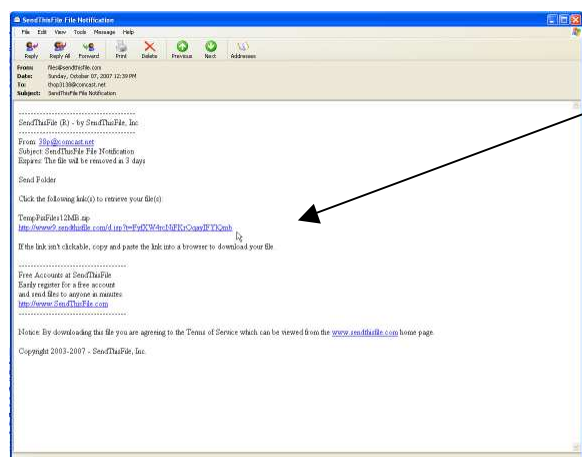

Receiving the File:

An E-Mail will be sent to the recipient notifying them of the file. Ref. Sample of E-Mail.. File..STF_03.bmp

To access the remote storage site and download the file click on the link provided in the E-Mail. See arrow in Fig. STF_03.bmp

Click on [Download] Fig. STF_04.bmp and select an appropriate location on the computer.

Sending multiple files at once:

To send multiple files, convert all the selected files to a “ Zip’d “ file. Use a program like “ Free Zip “ to convert to a Zip file.

FreeZip is a small, fast and efficient Zip utility for compression and decompression of files and directories. FreeZip integrates with Windows Explorer and uses file associations and context menus to zip or unzip files and subdirectories. If you know how to use Windows Explorer, then you do not have to learn anything new to use FreeZip. The setup is a single-click process and there are no options or settings involved. The manual is in English, Japanese, Polish, Italian, Swedish, German, Latvian, Spanish, French, Hungarian, Czech, Russian, Lithuanian, Belorussian, Portuguese and Chinese. FreeZip, WinZip, and most other Zip programs use identical compression code, originating from the same source. However, FreeZip is freely available for use and distribution.

FreeZip version 1.4.9 includes updated decompression code and a new format of documentation. If you want to protect your zip files with a password, download the encryption patch, or use [ZipCrypt](#) for best security. To create a self-extracting zip file, get the SFX patch. Multiple volumes can be easily made with [FileSplit](#). Do not hesitate to try out FreeZip, the uninstaller will leave no trace of it on your system, if you do not like it.

Click here to download the program. Save the downloaded file ... FreeZip.exe
Double click on the file FreeZip.exe to install the program on your computer.

Note: The program is accessible from Windows Explorer by selecting a folder containing your image files and R-Clicking then select [Zip] from the drop down menu.

Use Free Zip to combine several files into one zip file:

First... Create a folder under C:\ specifically for the files to be zipped.

Open Windows Explorer and select C:\ [File] [New] [Folder]

Give the new folder a name. Ex: **1-Images** The 1- will put the new folder near the top of the C: drive listing. [Ent]

Second... Copy all images into this folder.

Third... Highlight the **1-Images** folder with the image files in it. R-Click and select [Zip] The multiple image files will be compressed into one Zip file and automatically named **Free.Zip** This file can be renamed if desired. (Remember to keep the .Zip extension.)

Forth... This file.. Ex: **Free.zip** can be sent using the “Send This File “ as outlined on previous page.

The person receiving this e-mail and downloads the **Free.zip** file, can unzip this file to extract the individual image files.
